


How to make Neal's head

Step 1. This big circle is his head.




You can cut it out and stick it on cardboard or you can use a paper plate for his head if you like.

Step 2. Neal's eyeballs

He will need eyes. If you get two plastic milk bottle tops you can make his eyes. Just put a black dot in the middle of the bottle tops for his eyeballs. Then stick the milk bottle tops to his head. Then he will be looking at you! Helloooooo Neal!

Step 3. Neal's mouth

Neal can't talk properly yet but he needs a mouth. His mouth can be happy or sad or grumpy or you can make your own shape for Neal's mouth. You can use coloured paper or colour it in yourself.



Step 4. Neal's little bit of hair

Some strips of black paper can be his hair. You can use black crepe paper strips or colour it yourself. Get some glue and stick the hair to his head. Be careful, don't hurt him.

Step 5. His eyebrows and his nose.

You can make Neal's eyebrows by cutting out bits of coloured paper OR you can cut them out of white paper and colour them in yourself. Here are some eyebrow shapes for you to cut out, colour in and get you started.



His nose is just a little round red dot. You can colour and cut one yourself or you can get a red dot sticker if you have any. Tah Dah! Now you have your own Neal head!

P.S. You can give him a body if you want but you don't have to. His head is funny enough to have in your room or the back of the car or in the garden or to watch TV with you.

If you want to give him a body you can make it out of cardboard or you can get a baby jump suit, stuff it full of foam and tie his head on top. Charity shops have a lot baby clothes.
